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## ICSE AND ISC TOPPERS



We presented 62 children for the ICSE Board Examination and 21 for the ISC, and we secured a hundred percent pass rate at both the ICSE and ISC levels. This remarkable accomplishment highlights the hard work and dedication of both our students and teachers.

Aadith Rajesh is the ICSE topper with 98.6% marks. Thirteen students secured above 90%, 46 received distinctions, and 61 achieved first class. We have 1 centum in Physics, 2 in Chemistry, 4 in Biology, 2 in Home Science, 5 in History, and 1 in Physical Education.

Unnimaya Shine is the ISC School Topper with 99% marks. Sreehari M is the Science topper with 94.25% marks. Manikandan C V with 90%, is the Commerce topper. We have centums in Psychology and Political Science.
